EDMONTON – The Building Trades of Alberta Charitable Foundation will donate a total of \$110,000 to 11 food banks across the province to help the organizations relieve hunger and provide necessities to Albertans in need.

“While our province is recovering from one of the worst economic recessions seen in a generation, there are still many individual Albertans and families struggling to make ends meet,” said Building Trades of Alberta Executive Director, Terry Parker. “Food banks help close that gap.”
